










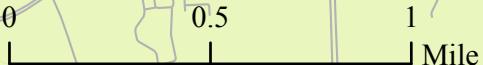
Beverly Randolph's Westham

-  Home of William Randolph II, Beverly's brother, built 1753
-  Site of Westham Foundry, a Revolutionary War magazine destroyed Jan. 4 1781
-  Westham Creek
-  Current Roads
-  Present Day Westham Station and Westham Road
-  Approximate footprint of 1751 Westham Settlement
-  University of Richmond
