1	Section 1 - Home Page <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explains what can be found on the site and how to navigate it. Grade level and topic appear here or in the header or title. Provides basic author information. 			
5	Section 2 - Content Includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Standards of Learning and relevant Common Core Standards Teacher Notes/Background Information (from the Curriculum Framework AND other sources) Vocabulary Content Resources 			
4	Section 3 - Notes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Includes include general information and links to resources for math instruction in general. May include, but is not limited to resources for manipulatives, writing in math (journals perhaps), ideas for vocabulary or word walls, bulletin boards, etc. 			
5	Section 4 - Annotated Bibliography <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Books - Includes an annotated list of at least 7 children's books useful for supporting instruction. Includes an image of each book cover and link to a publisher or purchasing site. Technology - Includes an annotated list of at least 5 web sites and/or apps useful in supporting instruction. Sites and apps are narrow, very specific to the topic, and written specifically for KIDS. Includes a screenshot and link to the resource. Uses APA format. 			
30	Section 5 - Unit Organizer <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provides an outline of the unit that highlights the objectives, learning targets, and formative assessments. Lesson plans are shared through Google Docs. Plans are highly detailed and follow the modified lesson plan format. Lessons support the selected Virginia SOL and appropriate for intended audience (i.e. student and grade level, level of difficulty, diverse learners, etc.) Lessons are reasonably differentiated Lessons include math workshop, rich-task and technology integration. 			
5	Section 6 - Assessment <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Narrative describes how students' overall performance and understanding will be evaluated. Includes copies of your summative assessment and all formative assessment materials, including any answer sheets and grading rubrics used for evaluating student work. Assessment resources support the selected Virginia Standards of Learning and are useful tools for evaluating student work and understanding.
