\$5,000 Scholarships for Diverse First-Year Law Students

Applicants are considered based on their involvement in community activities and diversity related student organizations, personal achievements, and law school and undergraduate academic performance.

Consistent with the objective of promoting diversity in legal education and leadership roles in the legal profession, McGuireWoods will also consider additional criteria including, among other factors, whether the applicant is:

- The first family member to attend college.
- From an economically disadvantaged family.
- A past or present member of the military.
- Demonstrating a strong commitment to promoting diversity in his or her undergraduate school, law school and community.

Application Packet Contents

- Completed application form.
- Current resume.
- Undergraduate & first semester law school transcripts (photocopy of official transcript is acceptable).
- Personal statement (limit of 1,500 words) explaining your commitment to diversity in the legal profession, community involvement and personal achievements. Tell us something that is not on your resume.

Completed application packet must be received by **5:00PM CST on May 27, 2016**. Scholarships will be awarded by July 1, 2016, paid directly to the law school for tuition and books only. Send materials via U.S. mail, e-mail or fax (*preferably email*) to:
